IDFI has <u>database</u> of FOI officers in charge of ensuring access to public information and proactive disclosure of information in various public institutions.

SUPPORTING PARLIAMENT OF GEORGIA INVOLVEMENT IN OPEN GOVERNMENT PARTNERSHIP INITIATIVE

The goal of the project Supporting Parliament of Georgia Involvement in Open Government Partnership Initiative is to increase openness and transparency of the Parliament of Georgia and ensure effective citizen participation in legislative processes through active engagement of the Parliament in OGP.

Within the project IDFI prepared <u>recommendations</u> about Formats for Publishing Information on the Web-page of the Parliament.

Regarding the changes in Open Government Partnership Steering Committee, which has new members: Indonesia, Chile and Romania IDFI published an <u>article</u> on the website.

On 14-15 September the Open Government Partnership's Legislative Openness Working Group <u>meeting</u> will be held in Tbilisi, Georgia.

Representatives of IDFI held a <u>training</u> for Librarians within the scopes of the Project about access to public information, Open Governance Partnership, proactive disclosure of public information and transparency of state budget.
