“On Creation the Inter-Factional Group to Ensure the Involvement of the Parliament of Georgia in “Open Government Partnership (OGP)” Initiative”¹

According to articles 103 and 107(“11” and “33.6”²) of the Parliament’s Rules of Procedure:

1. The Members of the Inter-Factional Group, who within Open Government Partnership project aim to establish the Open Parliament Principle, are:
 - a) Faction “The Georgian Dream” - Guguli Maghradze;
 - b) Faction “The Georgian Dream – Republicans” – Tinatin Khidasheli;
 - c) Faction “The Georgian Dream – National Forum” – Malkhaz Vakhtangashvili;
 - d) Faction “The Georgian Dream – Entrepreneurs” – Giorgi Kakhiani;
 - e) Faction “The Georgian Dream – Conservatives” – Giga Bukia;
 - f) Faction “Free Democrats” - Nino Gogvadze;
 - g) Faction “The United National Movement” – Khatuna Gogorishvili;
 - h) Faction “The National Movement – Regions” – Vakhtangi Lemojava;
 - i) Faction “The National Movement Majoritarians” – Davit Chavchanidze;
 - j) Faction “Independent Majoritarians – for Powerful Regions” – Gocha Enukidze;
 - k) Faction “Non-party, Independent Majoritarians” – Kakhaber Okriashvili.
2. The Inter-Factional Group is chaired by the member of the Parliament Tinatin Khidasheli.
3. Chair of the Inter-Factional Group convenes group at least once a month. Sessions are open, until its closure is requested by 2/3 of Inter-factional group members. Session is empowered if it is attended by a majority of the full composition of members. During the sessions decisions are adopted by the majority of attendees but by no less than 1/3 of all Inter-Factional Group members. Head of the Inter-Factional Group announces results of consultations with the Inter-Factional Group member political parties on the decisions before the voting is conducted.
- 3¹. The Inter-Factional Group within the course of its activities collaborates with non-governmental organizations and the representatives of the civil society.
4. An organizational, technical and expert service for Inter-Factional Group activities is provided by the Staff of the Parliament of Georgia.

5. The Inter-Factional Group should present the preliminary results of its work, particularly, Open Parliament Georgia Action Plan, to Parliament no later than September 1, 2015.
6. Authority of Inter-Factional Group is determined for one year.
7. Order enters into force upon the public announcement.
8. Order may be appealed within a month after its public announcement in the Administrative Branch of Kutaisi City Court (address: Kupradze st. 11, Kutaisi)
